**The ORIGINAL Method**

- Member does the DH and or Senior Proficiency Course
- Passes Theory and Practical
- Gets awarded the DH status awarded to them via CHASA (or by the member association if they are directly accredited to the SAPS)
- Once they are DH, they make application for DSS and pay the prescribed fee (no need to be CHASA Senior Proficient)
- CHASA (or if directly accredited the association) awards the DSS Status and number

**The NEW Method**

- Member does the new CHASA Direct-to-DSS Course
- Includes Theory and Practical (material available from Desire)
- Theory – is an written exam based on the DSS Manual
- Practical – is the DSS Shoot – 3 shots to hit an A4 target at 25m standing position
- Member passes and applies for DSS via CHASA application form
- CHASA awards Basic DSS Certificate (this may still to be designed)
- CHASA awards DSS and DSS number.

**MAINTAIN the DSS**

- A DSS member must shoot at least 2 CHASA Sports Shooting events (at this stage in any CHASA SS discipline) to maintain their CHASA DSS status
- Records kept by affiliate and most easily on the CHASA Ranking system
